DISABILITIES IN AMERICA



1 million people live with severe disabilities, 2 million people have a functional limitation, and 5 million people with a disability are youth.



The ACS data (2012-2016) shows that about 15.34% of the overall state's population is disabled which is higher than the national average of 12.8%. The counties in Oklahoma averages range from 9% to 31%. Counties with significant high portion of population with disabilities include Marshall, Pushmataha, Johnston, Sequoyah, and McIntosh.



15.6% of Oklahomans - almost one in six - have disabilities. 189,396 Oklahomans (all ages) have hearing difficulties. 128,037 Oklahomans (all ages) have vision difficulties. 208,732 Oklahomans (age 5 and up) have cognitive difficulties.



The Office of Mobility and Public Transit was signed into law in May 2019 in hopes to make transportation easier for people with disabilities. The Governor directed ODOT to work to increase miblity for all.
