## TORNADO AND ROAD SAFETY



**Get off the road.** The best options are to drive to a designated shelter, basement or safe room. The next best option is a small, windowless room or hallway on the lowest floor or a sturdy building.



**DO NOT** seek refuge in a vehicle, outside or under an overpass. A highway overpass does not provide safety from a tornado



**If the tornado is imminent** and you are forced to stay in your car, keep your seat belt on and making sure your head is covered. Stay below windows if possible.



**DO NOT** seek shelter under an overpass or tree. This put you at greater risk of being killed or seriously injured by flying debris from the powerful tornado winds.



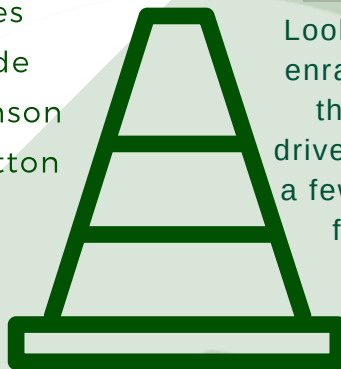
## JAMM'N Success Story

## PROTECT YOURSELF IN ROAD RAGE SITUATIONS



Look straight ahead, don't engage with an enraged driver. Roll up your windows: lock the doors. Pull over and let the enraged driver pass. Instead of shouting back, take a few deep breathes and count backwards from 20. If an angry driver follows you, don't get out of your vehicle. Go to a public space. Refrain from using the horn.



## LIFT MAINTENANCE IMPORTANCE

Run lift through a cycle daily before starting shift. Lifts should be lubed monthly and noted on pre-trips.
