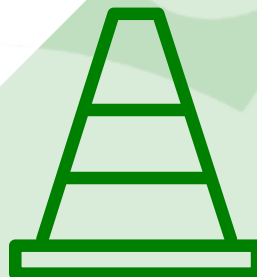
JAMM'N SUCCESS STORIES

For the 2018 calendar year we provided 145,897 trips to the public across the four county service area. 22,895 trips were completed by senior citizens, 22,002 trips were completed by person's with disabilities, and 101,000 trips were completed by public passengers.
